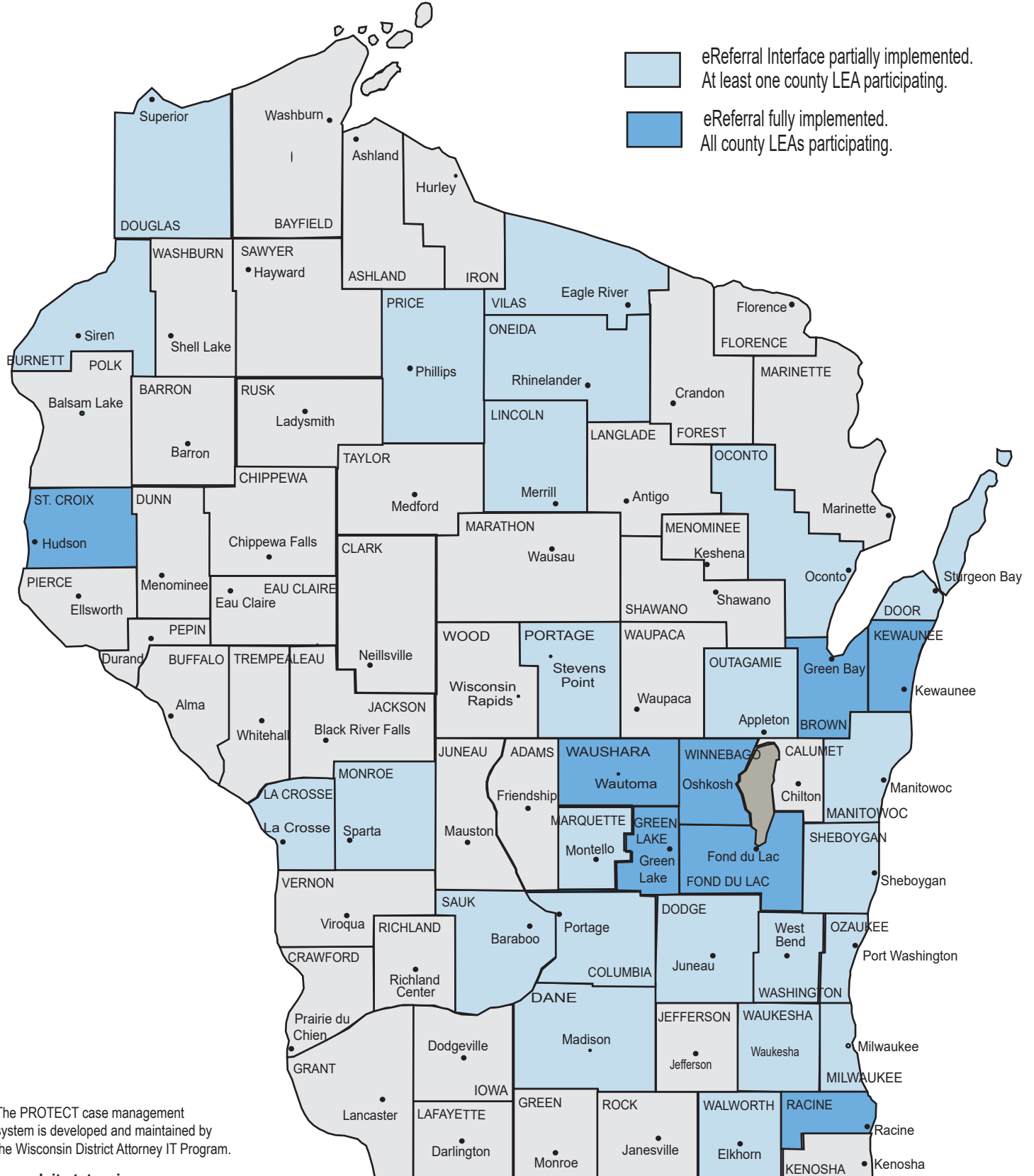


EREFERRAL IMPLEMENTATION STATUS

Current as of February 1, 2018

The case management system, PROTECT, is used by all Wisconsin District Attorney offices and includes a number of state-standard interfaces with case management / records management systems used in Wisconsin's circuit courts, and at the Department of Justice and Department of Transportation. Examples of data exchanged are: new and amended adult and juvenile court case filings, court calendar information, hearing notes, charge and case dispositions, arrest details, and criminal and non-criminal citation details.

An optional eReferral Interface enables county law enforcement to send referral information (incident, case party, arrest, referred charges, officer narratives, attachments, etc.) electronically from their own systems, directly to their District Attorney's PROTECT database, for review and charging decision.



The PROTECT case management system is developed and maintained by the Wisconsin District Attorney IT Program.
